

Side Saddle Stitch

This stitch has excellent structure and works well for blankets, dishcloths, and scarves. The combination of height and compactness makes it both decorative and durable.

Beginner's Guide to the Side Saddle Stitch in Crochet

The Side Saddle Stitch is a textured crochet stitch that produces a beautiful, subtle ridge pattern, resembling a row of tiny saddles across your fabric. It's a versatile stitch that adds interest and depth to any project, yet it's simple enough for beginners to learn.

This stitch works well for blankets, scarves, cushion covers, and afghans, giving a clean, structured look while maintaining softness. Its unique texture is ideal for creating visual interest in both single-color and multi-color projects.

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Understanding the Side Saddle Stitch

The Side Saddle Stitch is worked by combining single crochets (SC) and double crochets (DC) in a staggered pattern. The alternating height of stitches creates a subtle ridge that runs horizontally across the fabric. This texture is similar to the look of a "saddle," hence the name.

It's a stitch that's forgiving for beginners because it repeats a predictable rhythm, allowing you to focus on tension and stitch consistency while creating an eye-catching texture.

Abbreviation

Step by Step

Side Saddle Stitch Step-by-Step Instructions (US Terms)

Abbreviations (US → UK)

ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US) → dc (UK)

dc = double crochet (US) → tr (UK)

st(s) = stitch(es)

sk = skip

sp = space

rep = repeat

Foundation:

Start with a multiple of 4 + 2 chains.

(Example: ch 26 for a small sample.)



1. Work 1 sc in the 2nd ch from hook. Chain 3,
2. Work 4 dc cluster in next 4 stitches, finish of cluster, chain1, 1sc into the next stitch(complete first cluster stitch,
3. * chain3, work 4 dc cluster in next 4 stitches, finish of cluster, chain1, 1sc into the next stitch,
4. Repeat from * across. Turn.

Row 2 Establishing the Pattern:

1. Ch 2 (counts as first dc), work 2 dc in same st (this forms a 3-dc group).
2. Skip next 2 dc, work 1 sc in space between the 2 skipped dc and the next 3-dc group, ch 2, work 3 dc in next sc.
3. Repeat from to across. Turn.

Row 3 and onward:

Repeat Row 2 for the rest of your project.

As you continue, your clusters and single crochets will alternate diagonally, forming the "saddle" texture.

UK Equivalent

In UK crochet terms:

Single crochet (SC) → Double crochet (DC)

Double crochet (DC) → Treble crochet (TR)

The pattern remains the same; only the stitch names change.

Crochet Stitch Practice Example

Practice Swatch Exercise

1. Chain 22 (or any multiple of 3 + 1).
2. Work Row 1 (SC, skip 2, DC, repeat).
3. Follow Row 2 for 6–8 rows.
4. Observe how the ridges form horizontally across the fabric.
5. Experiment with tension and stitch placement to master the texture.
