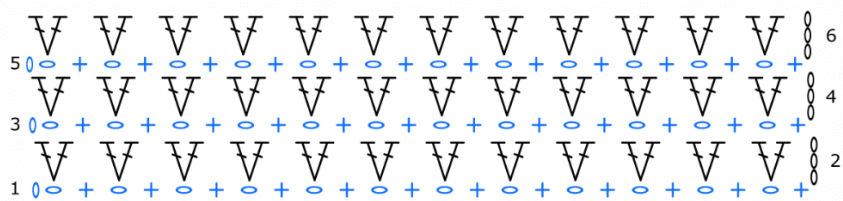

US: (ch) - chain

UK: (ch) - chain

(sc) single crochet

(dc) double crochet

(ch3) chain 3

(ch3) chain 3

(2dc) two double crochet

(2tr) two treble crochet

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Brick Stitch

The Brick Stitch is built by alternating rows of chain stitches and clusters of double crochets. The chain rows act as mortar lines, while the clusters form the bricks.

Beginner's Guide to the Brick Stitch

The Brick Stitch, also known as the Block Stitch or Brick Wall Stitch, is a bold and colorful crochet pattern that mimics the look of a brick wall. It's made using a combination of double crochet clusters and chain spaces, stacked in alternating rows to form neat



This stitch is ideal for blankets, scarves, and home décor projects, especially when worked in multiple colors. The Brick Stitch not only looks impressive but also helps beginners practice color changes and stitch spacing consistency while creating a dense yet soft fabric.

What Is the Brick Stitch?

The Brick Stitch is built by alternating rows of chain stitches and clusters of double crochets. The chain rows act as mortar lines, while the clusters form the bricks.

In UK crochet terms, this stitch is often worked using treble crochet (tr) instead of double crochet (dc).

It's an easy two-row repeat that's perfect for creating geometric, structured patterns. By switching colors every two rows, you can highlight the brick-like structure beautifully.

Step by Step

Step-by-Step Instructions (US Terms)

US Abbreviation: dc

UK Abbreviation: tr

Foundation Row:

Chain an even number of stitches + 1 (for turning).

Row 1:

Single crochet (sc) into the second chain from the hook, chain 1, skip 1 chain, sc into next.

Repeat from to across. Turn.

Row 2 (Brick Row):

Change color if desired. Chain 3 (counts as first dc), work 2 dc into each chain-1 space across the row. End with 1 dc in the last



stitch. Turn.

Row 3 (Mortar Row):

Switch back to your background color. Chain 1, sc into first stitch, chain 1, skip 2 dc, sc between clusters.

Repeat from to across. Turn.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 to continue building your "brick wall." Alternate colors every two rows for a classic effect.

Crochet Stitch Practice Example

Practice Row Example

Try this mini sample to get the hang of the stitch:

1. Chain 21.
2. Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1, skip 1, sc in next. Turn.
3. Row 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each ch-1 space across. Turn.
4. Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, sc between clusters. Turn.
5. Repeat Rows 2-3, changing color every two rows.

You'll see the "brick" pattern begin to form after just a few repeats!
