What is a temperature blanket

A temperature blanket is when you create a blanket or afghan and crochet one row for each day of the year, with the color of each row determined by the temperature for that day. Temperature blanket makes a great heirloom blanket for you and your family to treasure for years to come. It's a fun way to record the temperature of your local climate and perhaps capture a great memory for a significant time in your life.

Crochet Stitches for your temperature blanket

The 365 All year round temperature blanket pattern includes over 30 mixed crochet blanket stitch pattern stitches, from the easy half double crochet stitch to the moss stitch, some stripped granny stitches, a few variations of the half double crochet V stitches, some combinations of the half double crochet puff stitches and many more pretty crochet blanket stitch patterns.

Before you start your crochet temperature blanket make sure that you make a gauge swatch, this will help you to use the sizing chart found within the pattern, the sizing chart will give you the exact amount of starting chain stitches for the blanket size you require, more on this is the sections below,

The 365 all-year-round crochet temperature blanket pattern includes a detailed sizing chart with additional instructions on making your required blanket size, from single, to twin or double-sized bedspreads, as well as larger sizes for queen, king, and king XL beds



Crochet Stitches

Here are 3 different easy crochet stitches which can be used of a temperature blanket

Option A

Row	Pattern Row Instructions
A	Ch 2, * 1hdc into hdc st, repeat from *
B	Ch 2, * 1hdc into hdc st, repeat from *
C	Ch 2, * 1hdc into hdc st, repeat from *
D	Ch 2, * 1hdc into hdc st, repeat from *
E	Ch 2, * 1hdc into hdc st, repeat from *



Determine your temperature range

You will need to start by knowing the highest and lowest average daily temperature for your area.

The best practice perhaps is to look at the previous year's temperatures, this will give you a good indication of the temperature of the year to come. I suggest visiting your favorite weather website and making a quick note of the highest and lowest daily average temperatures for each month.

This will give you at least 12 months' worth of information on the min and maximum temperatures, for your area and a great starting point for planning your blanket. Doing a bit of homework helps you have a better idea of the range of temperatures, and will save you some money in the long run as you won't have skeins of yarn colors that are left over or not even used once your blanket is complete..

Selecting your yarn and colors

When selecting a yarn for your blanket , pick a yarn which is easily accessible , and colors which you know you will be able to get if you run out, I do mention the total qty that I used for the blanket pattern, but remember that all climates differ so your color choice and your area temperatures will determine how many skeins you will use per color.

Select your own custom temperature range

Using the table above you can now see what the overall min and max temperatures are for your area, the color choice is completely up to you, if you wish to have a lot of color variations in your rows then use one color per temperature, if you live in a climate where there is a huge temperature shift and have a large temperature range then perhaps consider changing colors every 2 to 3° degrees.

I use up to 16 different colors for my example blanket as we live in a warm climate that has a range of 16 temperatures between our warmest day and our coldest day. Having a different color for each row makes the stripes more vivid. I have only a few rows where I had the same temperature exactly for two days in a row.

If you wish to create your own temperature color swatch, you will need to start by knowing the highest and lowest average daily temperature for your area.

The best practice perhaps is to look at the previous year's temperatures, this will give you a good indication of the temperature of the year to come. I suggest visiting your favorite weather website and making a quick note of the highest and lowest daily average temperatures for each month.

This will give you at least 12 months' worth of information on the min and maximum temperatures, for your area and a great starting point for planning your blanket.

Doing a bit of homework helps you have a better idea of the range of temperatures, and will save you some money in the long run as you won't have skeins of yarn colors that are left over or not even used once your blanket is complete.

Example pattern sizes are based on using a 3.5mm crochet hook, double knit yarn.
If you want to use a bigger hook and different yarn weight please take note of the sizing chart below, which will assist you in getting the right size blanket for your requirements.

Remember this is a temperature blanket , and requires the full 365/6 rows to be worked for the year.

If you prefer a heavier and larger hook, you can still enjoy and make the blanket but then I would suggest rather opting for two separate blankets.

Please take note of the sizing chart and how to create a gauge swatch information below, this section will assist you in getting the right size blanket for your blanket size requirements.

Make a Size / Gauge swatch

- Chain 12 sts work 6 rows of 1 hdc (half double crochet stitches) in each stitch,
- Finish off the swatch,
- Measure square width.

How to determine your starting chain length ?

Use the table below to determine your starting chains required.

Examples :

Gauge swatch width : 2.5' / 6.3 cm wide

Blanket size required : Twin (63' x 95' / 160 x 240 cm)

Chain : 290

Gauge swatch width : 3' / 7.6 cm wide

Blanket size required : King (108' x 100' / 275 x 255 cm)

Chain : 398

See table below for swatch sizes and starting chains please note, below sizes exclude border width.
This table will give you an estimated size, we all are different so your final blank size might be slightly smaller or bigger, depending on your own personal tension.

Example Length of blanket is based on example blanket size and using a 3.5mm crochet hook, please note if you have a larger crochet hook and bigger swatch as indicated in the tension notes your blanket length will be different from the finished blanket size. All rows follow in sequins, and you can simply end your row when you have received the required length.
